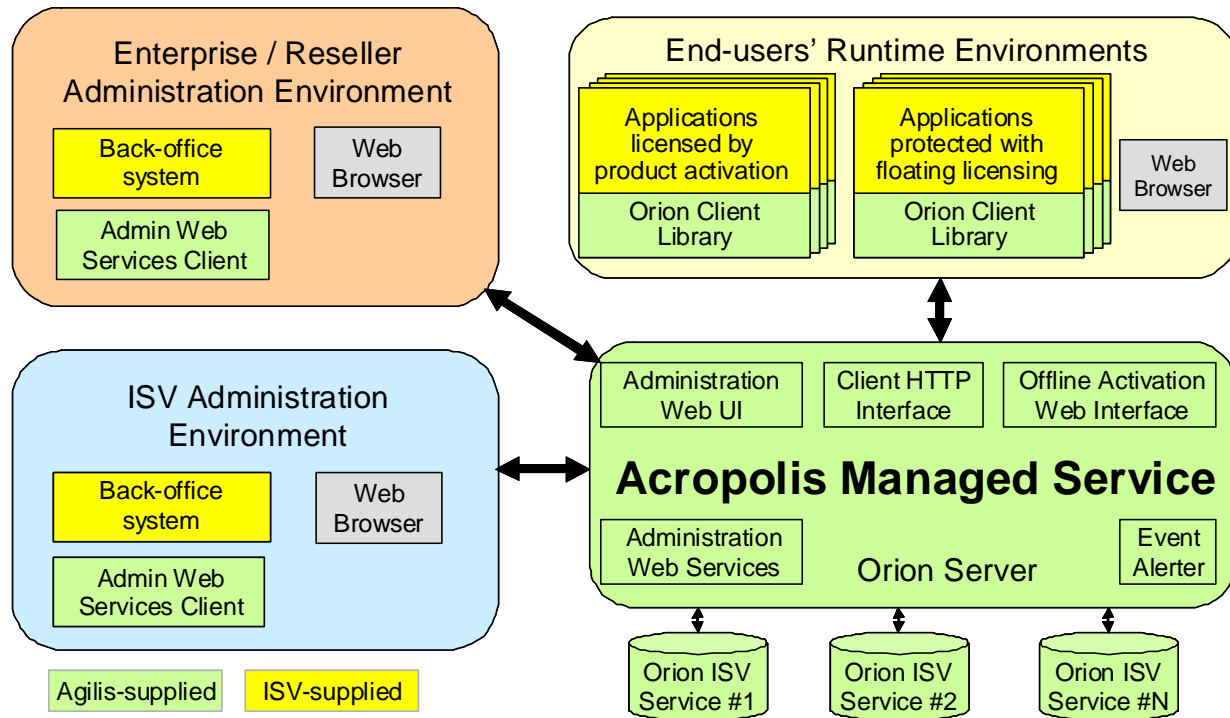


**WHAT ACROPOLIS IS, AND WHO IT IS FOR**

Acropolis is an on-demand license management service for software and hardware/software system vendors who protect their products with Internet-based licensing using Agilis’s Orion Network Licensing Platform ([www.agilis-sw.com/orion](http://www.agilis-sw.com/orion)). Acropolis supports Orion’s product activation and Internet-based floating licensing capabilities on both connected and disconnected systems.

**VALUE PROPOSITION**

The primary business problems being solved by Acropolis are:

- **Control operations cost:** rein in the cost of software license administration operations to the vendors
- **Eliminate infrastructure cost:** eliminate the cost of purchasing, setting up and operating the associated hardware, operating system and license server infrastructure, and
- **Provide insights into business:** add further value by providing auditing capabilities for compliance management, and business intelligence reporting for planning purposes.

The cost of subscribing to the Acropolis service is a fraction of the cost of owning and operating an equivalent infrastructure. The difference is magnified when the infrastructure needs to otherwise be constructed or purchased. Acropolis is competitively priced, with an entry level fee that makes it affordable for small-to-medium vendors.



## DESCRIPTION

In addition to hosting all the necessary hardware, OS and license server at a Tier 1 data center, an Acropolis subscription includes services for managing license server uptime, setting up and managing license databases and services, and maintaining the vendor's license from Agilis. Browser-based user interfaces are provided for self-service license entitlement, auditing and reporting over the Internet. Vendors can also automate license generation, reporting and administration from their back-office systems via Web Services, the remote Java API or remote command-line integration tools. Optional operations and integration services are also available.

Data is owned by the vendor, who may selectively export and download it at any time. Vendors also have the option of migrating their database in order to subsequently host their service themselves.

## PRICING

Pricing is subscription-based and depends on your particular requirements but always meets Agilis's commitment to offering pricing that is competitive with market alternatives. The following service tiers are offered:

- **Core management services**  
Multi-tenant, medium capacity, suitable for tens of thousands of licenses.
- **Premium management services**  
Multi-tenant, high capacity, suitable for reseller models and hundreds of thousands of licenses.
- **Dedicated management services**  
Single-tenant, suitable for vendors requiring failover configurations, Orion server plug-ins, hosting of branded user interfaces.

Note a separate Orion license is required.
